







Tri-University FAFSA Checklist

Please make sure you have applied to at least one of the three state universities before you begin working on this checklist.

Please have the following items with you before starting the 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (fafsa.gov):

Students

FSA ID username and password. U.S. citizens: Social Security number. Eligible non-citizens: Social Security number and Alien Registration number. Primary email address and password. Home address.

Phone number.

Copy of 2021 tax return, all 2021 W-2s and any untaxed income.

Parents

FSA ID username and password. U.S. citizens and eligible non-citizens: Social Security number.

If undocumented: Use zeros for Social Security number.

Date(s) of birth.

Date parents were married, remarried, separated, divorced or widowed.

If parent(s) are deceased, month and year of death(s).

Copy of 2021 tax return(s), records of untaxed income.

Current cash balances, savings account balances, checking account balances, and investments.

Primary email address and password.

^{*}Undocumented students, including DACA recipients, are not eligible for federal student aid. However, you may still be eligible for university aid, in addition to private scholarships. Check with your admission representative.

^{**}Students in a legal guardianship or in foster care do not need any parent information.
